BEAN PRODUCER ANNOUNCES NEW 15.5 OZ. FOODSERVICE CANS

The 15.5 oz. can size was created to provide foodservice operators with smaller ingredient requirements more flexibility with the products they stock. This new format reflects Furmano's commitment to creating ideal solutions to meet their customer's needs.

"We wanted to better serve our customers who might not need bulk ingredients to produce their menu," said Yvonne Derr, Product Line Marketing Manager at Furmano Foods. "With over 70 ounces of drained beans, our #10 cans aren't for everyone, so we created a more flexible solution."

The new 15.5 oz. cans will be sold in 24-packs, which lets chefs open only what's needed for a particular side dish or special menu item. They can now leave the unopened cans in dry storage instead of covering and refrigerating the unused portion of the #10 can. This reduces potential waste, creates more cost-efficiencies and gives chefs more flexibility with inventory, menu creation and storage.

The smaller format also gives chefs more freedom in menu creation and experimentation. They can try new recipes or side dishes that use beans without the worry of wasting a large unused portion. The potential increase in variety allows them to take advantage of beans as a great source of protein and fiber.

"As a chef, there are times when something only comes in bulk packaging and we simply don't need all that product," said Chef Paul Burkholder, a Certified Research Chef for Furmano Foods. "Instead of trying to move through all 70 ounces, you get 2-3 servings out of a single 15.5 oz. can."

The full lineup of beans offered in the new 15.5 oz. format includes Dark Red Kidney, White Kidney (Cannellini), Vegetarian, Great Northern, Black in Brine, Light Red Kidney, Chick Peas (Garbanzo Beans), Pinto and Butter Beans in Sauce.
